GREEKS AIDING MACEDONIANS.

The Rising Against Turkey Assumes Threatening Proportions.

LONDON, July 27.—Advices received here are to the effect that the rising in Macedonia against the Turkish authority is rapidly assuming a more than usually threatening aspect, and that the disaffection is spreading in Thessaly. A number of Greeks have gone to the aid of the rebels and have been received with much enthusiasm by the Macedonians.

A Revolutionary Committee at Larissa is almost openly engaged in the work of enrolling volunteers for service in the rebel ranks.

The Porte charges that the Greek Government is conniving at the attempts of the insurgents to overthrow Turkish rule in Macedonia, and that non-commissioned officers and privates of the Greek Army are among those who are aiding the reb-
